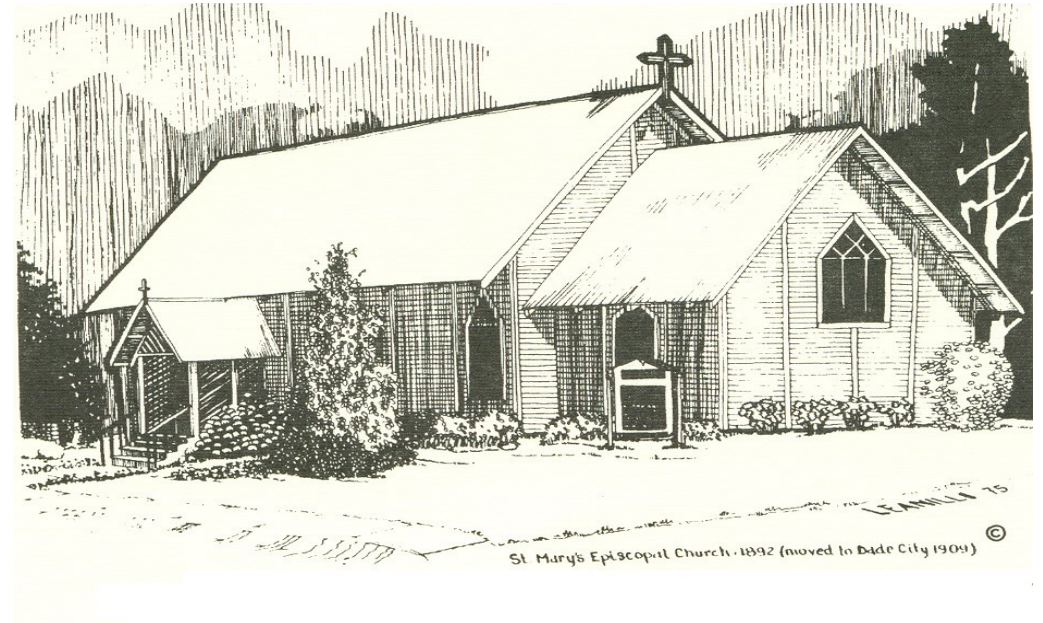
- Pencils, Pencil Boxes
