 We do it again August 13, 2017

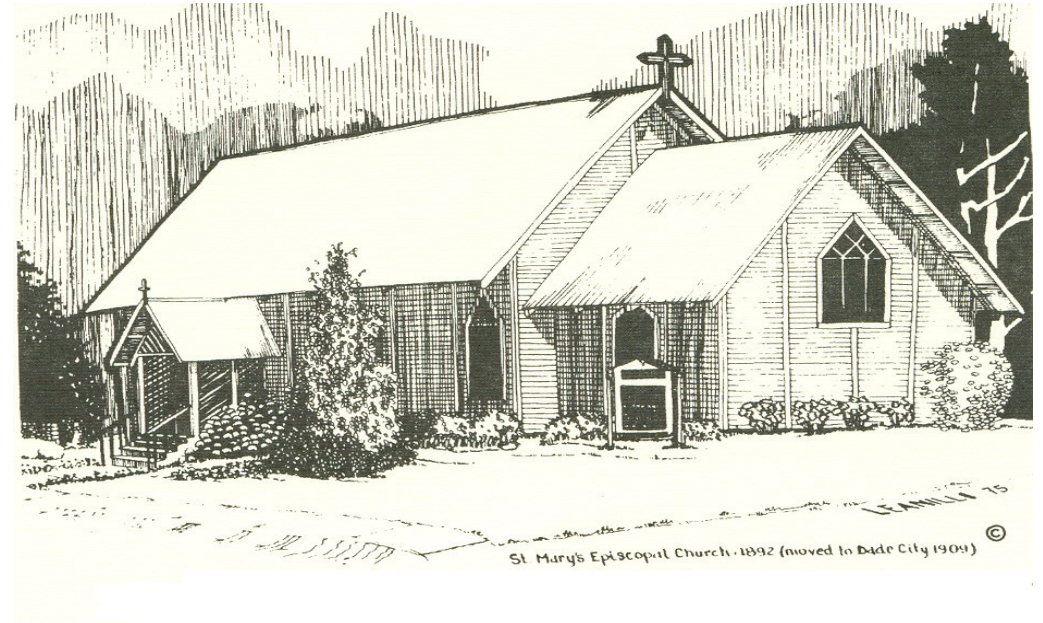
