The Vestry will meet Sunday, May 26 after the 10 am service in Tanno Hall.

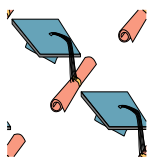
Love One Another will happen again Sunday, June 9. Sign-up sheets are in the Parish Hall. You can help by:

Buy One Get One becomes a Buy One GIVE One, when you bring one of those BOGO items to church for Food to Share and place it in the basket at the entrance.



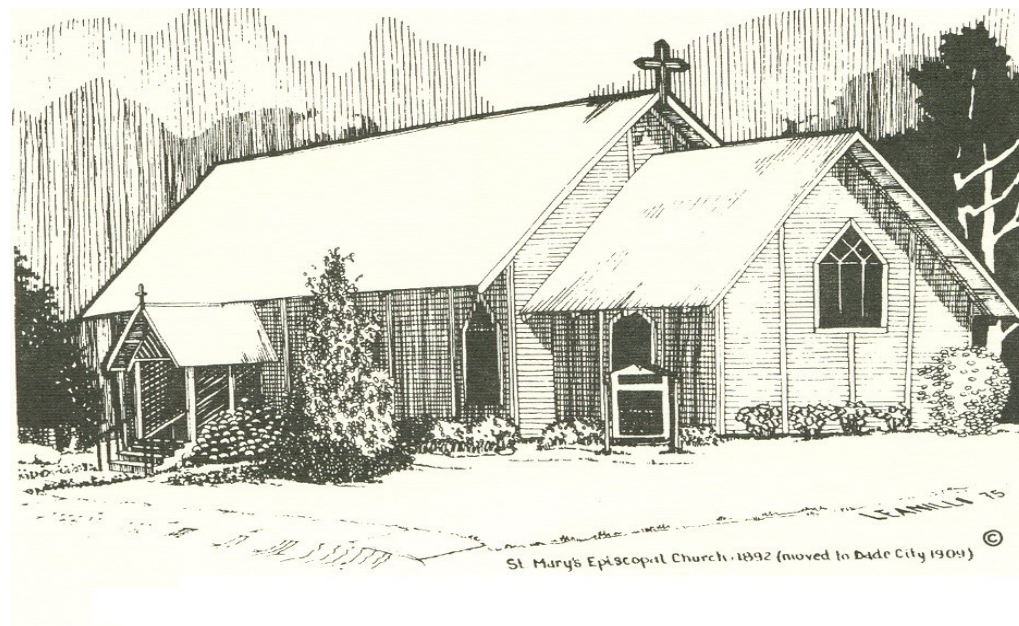
