Only two more weeks to order t-shirts and polo shirts with the St. Mary's logo. Sample shirts and the order sheets are in Freeman Hall.

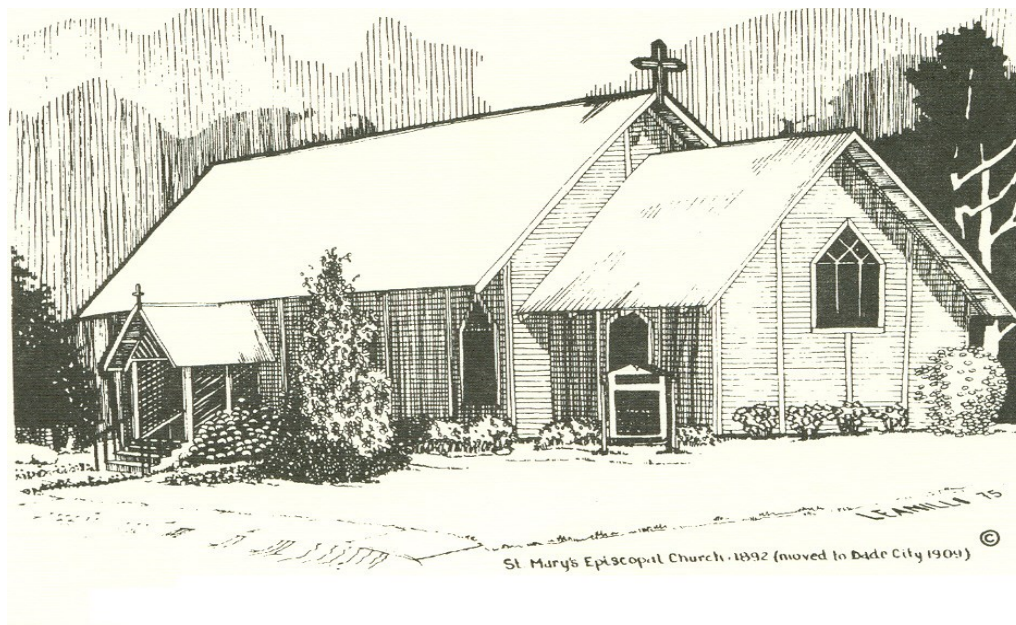
The Handmaidens of St. Mary's:
